Brown Heather

1 skein for Toy - Medium Breed Dogs

2 skeins for Large-Giant Breed Dogs

Crochet Hook

Size H (5.0 mm)

or size needed for gauge

SIZE INFORMATION

Sizes: Toy Breed , Small Breed, Medium Breed, Large Breed, Giant Breed

GAUGE INFORMATION

16 sts and 12 rows to 4" [10 cm] measured over Basket weave using **suggested** needles or any size needles which will give the correct stitch gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

ch chain

st(s) stitch(es)

SC single crochet

DC double crochet

FPDC front post double crochet

BPDC back post double crochet

FPHDC front post half double crochet

BPHDC back post half double crochet

cm centimeters

mm millimeter

rep repeat



Notes:

This cowl pattern is great for customizing. We recommend you measure the neck circumference and your dogs girth before starting your cowl. We also recommend you select your size based off of your dog's girth measurements. If you need to add

to the width of your cowl you can add an additional set of 3 stitches to make a half size but we suggest you feel confident with the basketweave pattern first. Thank you for crafting with us.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Work foundation chain in multiples 6 plus 3. The total number of chains we recommend are: 9 toy, 15 small, 21 medium, 27 large, 33 for giant breeds. These are recommended sizes and can be adjusted to best fit your dogs girth and collar length.

Basket Weave Stitch

Row 1: DC in the third chain from the hook and each ch to the end, turn

Row 2-3: Ch 3 (does not count as a st) FPDC around each of the first three DCs in row 1, BPDC around each of the next set of 3 DCs in row 1, rep to the end, turn.

Row 4-6: Ch 3 (does not count as a st) BPDC in the next 3 sts, FPDC in the next 3 sts rep to the end, turn

Toy Breed Dogs

Rep row 2 (3 times) then row 6 (3 times) of the basket weave pattern until you have 2 inches (6 rows) ending on a row 6 to begin shaping for the curve.

Small Breed Dogs

Rep row 2 (3 times) then row 6 (3 times) of the basket weave pattern until you have 4 inches (12 rows) ending on a row 6 to begin shaping for the curve.

Medium Breed Dogs

Rep row 2 (3 times) then row 6 (3 times) of the basket weave pattern until you have 6 inches (18 rows) ending on as row 6 to begin shaping for the curve.

Large Breed Dogs

Rep row 2 (3 times) then row 6 (3 times) of the basket weave pattern until you have 8 inches (24 rows) ending on a row 6 to begin shaping for the curve.

Giant Breed Dogs

Rep row 2 (3 times) then row 6 (3 times) of the basket weave pattern until you have 10 inches (30 rows) ending on a row 6 to begin shaping for the curve.

Shaping for the curve

Toy Breed Dogs

Row 1: CH 1, SC in the back loop only in the next 2 sts, BPHDC, FPDC in the next 3 sts, turn

Row 2: Ch 3 (does not count as a st) BPDC in the next 3 sts, 1FPHDC, SC in the back loop only in the next 2 sts, turn

Row 3: Ch 1, SC in the back loop only in the next 2 sts, BPHDC, FPDC in the next 3 sts, ch 2 and turn

Row 4: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), FPDC in the next 3 sts, 1BPHDC, SC in the back loop only in the next 2 sts, ch 1 turn

Row 5: Ch 1, SC in the back loop only in the next 2 sts, 1 FPHDC, 3BPDC, turn

Row 6: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPHDC, SC in the back loop only in the next 2 sts, ch 1 turn

work until the ribbed length reaches neck circumference 4-8 Inches then continue in basket weave stitch until desired length. We recomend 2 inches.

Small Breed Dogs

Row 1: Ch 1, SC in the back loop only in the next 3 sts, BPHDC in the next 3 sts, FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts, FPHDC in the next 3 sts, SC in the back loop only in the next 3 sts, turn

Row 3: Ch 1, SC in the back loop only in the next 3 sts, BPHDC in the next 3 sts, FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), BPDC in the next 3 sts, FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPHDC in the next 3 sts, SC in the back loop only in the next 3 sts, turn

Row 5: Ch 1, SC in the back loop only in the next 3 sts, FPHDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts, FPDC in the next 3 sts, turn.

Row 6: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), BPDC in the next 3 sts, FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPHDC in the next 3 sts, SC in the back loop only in the next 3 sts, turn

work until the ribbed length reaches neck circumference 8-14 Inches then continue in basket weave stitch until desired length. We recomend 4 inches.

Medium Breed Dogs

Row 1: Ch 1, SC in the back loop only in the next 6 sts, BPHDC in the next 3 sts, FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts, FPDC in the next 3 sts, turn

Row 2: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), BPDC in the next 3 sts, FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts, FPHDC in the next 3 sts, SC in the back loop only in the next 6 sts, turn

Row 3: Ch 1, SC in the back loop only in the next 6 st, BPHDC in the next 3 st, FPDC in the next 3 stitches, BPDC in the next 3 st, FPDC in the next 3 st, turn

Row 4: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts, FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPHDC in the next 3 sts, SC in the back loop only in the next 6 sts, turn

Row 5: Ch 1, SC in the back loop only in the next 6 sts, FPHDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts, FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts, turn

Row 6: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts, FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPHDC in the next 3 sts, SC in the back loop only in the next 6 sts, turn
work until the ribbed length reaches neck circumference 10-22 Inches then continue in basket weave stitch until desired length. We recomend 6 inches.

Large Breed Dogs

Row 1: Ch 1, SC in the back loop only in the next 9 sts, BPHDC in the next 3 sts, (FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts,) repeat 2 times, turn

Row 2: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), (BPDC in the next 3 sts, FPDC in the next 3 sts,) rep 2 times, FPHDC in the next 3 sts, SC in the back loop only in the next 9 sts, turn

Row 3: Ch 1, SC in the back loop only in the next 9 sts, BPHDC in the next 3 sts, (FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts,) rep 2 times, turn

Row 4: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), (FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts,) rep 2 times, FPHDC in the next 3 sts, SC in the back loop only in the next 9 sts, turn

Row 5: Ch 1, SC in the back loop only in the next 9 sts, BPHDC in the next 3 sts, (FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts,) rep 2 times, turn

Row 6: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), (FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts,) rep 2 times, FPHDC in the next 3 sts, SC in the back loop only in the next 9 sts, turn

work until the ribbed length reaches neck circumference 16-30 Inches then continue in basket weave stitch until desired length. We recomend 8 inches.

Giant Breed Dogs

Row 1: Ch 1, SC in the back loop only in the next 9 sts, BPHDC in the next 3 sts, (FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts,) rep 3 times, turn

Row 2: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), (BPDC in the next 3 sts, FPDC in the next 3 sts,) rep 3 times, FPHDC in the next 3 sts, SC in the back loop only in the next 9 sts, turn

Row 3: Ch 1, SC in the back loop only in the next 9 sts, BPHDC in the next 3 sts, (FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts,) rep 3 times, turn

Row 4: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), (FPDC in the next 3 st, BPDC in the next 3 st,) rep 3 times, FPHDC in the next 3 st, SC in the back loop only in the next 9 st, turn

Row 5: Ch 1, SC in the back loop only in the next 9 st, BPHDC in the next 3 st, (FPDC in the next 3 st, BPDC in the next 3 sts,) rep 3 times, turn

Row 6: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), (FPDC in the next 3 sts, BPDC in the next 3 sts,) rep 3 times, FPHDC in the next 3 sts, SC in the back loop only in the next 9 sts, turn

work until the ribbed length reaches neck circumference 24-36 Inches then continue in basket weave stitch until desired length. We recomend 10 inches

Finishing your work

Finish your dog cowl by weaving in ends and sewing buttons. We used 1 inch buttons that easily slid through out stitches and secured our cowl. We suggest tacking all three sides of the bottom triangle of your cowl so the garment keeps its shape while your dog moves and plays.
