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## Knit Baby Ripple Blanket

Size: 37 x 42" [94 x 106.5 cm]

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### Materials: Mary Maxim Worsted Weight yarn

Main Color	White	6 balls
Color 1	Denim Blue or Pink	2 balls
Color 2	Spring Green	2 balls

### Suggested Needles:

One 24" circular needle size 8 US, (Canadian 24" size 6, Metric 60 cm size 5.00 mm)

### TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

**Gauge or Tension:** One rep of 14 sts = 3" [10 cm] and 16 rows to 2 1/4" [6 cm], measured over pattern using **suggested** needle or any size needle which will give the correct stitch gauge or tension.

Please follow washing instructions printed on yarn label.

**Abbreviations:** MC, Main Color; k, knit; p, purl; st, stitch; sts, stitches; beg, begin or beginning; dec, decrease or decreasing; inc, increase or increasing; ", inches; yds, yards; gm, gram; cm, centimeters; mm, millimeter; rem, remain or remaining; rep, repeat; sl, slip; yo, yarn over; tog, together.

### Special Abbreviation:

**DD - Double Decrease:** Slip next 2 stitches onto right-hand needle as if to k2tog, knit next stitch from left-hand needle, then pass the 2 slipped stitches over the knit stitch at the same time - one stitch remains.

**To Make:** Using MC, cast on 171 sts.

Work in pattern as follows:

**Row 1:** (right side) K2, \*yo, k5, DD, k5, yo, k1; rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Row 2:** K1, p to last st, k1.

**Rows 3 and 4:** Knit.

**Rows 5 and 9:** Work as Row 1.

**Rows 6 and 10:** Work as Row 2.

**Rows 7 and 8:** Knit.

**Row 11:** Knit.

Change to Color 1 and continue as follows:

**Rows 12, 13 and 15:** K1, p to last st, k1.

**Rows 14 and 16:** Knit.

These 16 rows form pattern.

Keep Rows 1-11 in MC yarn only and Rows 12-16 in contrast color, alternating Colors 1 and 2.

Now rep these 16 rows 16 times more, thus ending after a Color 1 rep.

Now rep Rows 1-11 once more.

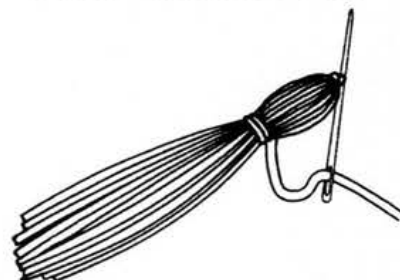
Cast off knitwise.

**Optional Tassels:** (make 7 each of Colors 1 and 2) Cut yarn into 12" [30.5 cm] lengths. Use 10 lengths for one tassel. Cut a 4" [10 cm] length of the same color and knot around the center of these lengths to form ties. Fold these lengths in half. Using a 6" [15 cm] length of the same color, wrap around top of tassel about 1" [2.5 cm] below fold, several times, then secure ends.

Trim ends of tassel to neaten.

Using ties, sew a tassel to each point on bottom end (or cast on edge) of blanket alternately across.
