

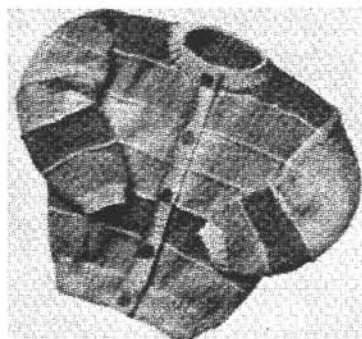
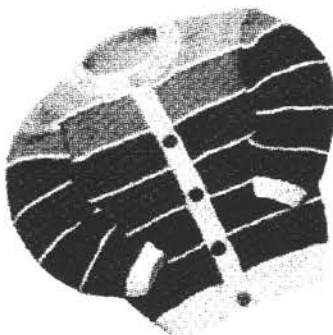

Bright Combination

Sizes 4-6-8-10-12

Color 1:	White or Black	2 balls
Color 2:	Green	1 ball
Color 3:	Blue	1 ball
Color 4:	Purple	1 ball
Color 5:	Red	1 ball
Color 6:	Orange	1 ball
Color 7:	Yellow	1 ball

Pastel Combination

Sizes 4-6-8-10-12

White	2 balls
Green	2 balls
Blue	2 balls
Pink	1 ball
Yellow	1 ball
Green	Use color 2
Blue	Use color 3

American: One pair each American Gauge Knitting Needles size 5 and size 7.

Canadian: One pair each Canadian Gauge Knitting Needles size 9 and size 7

Metric: One pair each Metric Gauge Knitting Needles size 3.75 and 4.50.

TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE!

Gauge or Tension: 20 sts and 26 rows to 4" [10 cm] measured over Stockinette stitch using suggested larger needles or any size needles which will give the correct stitch gauge or tension.

Measurements:

Finished Chest Measurement: 27½(29-31-34-37)" [70(74-79-86-94)cm]

Length from Back Neck: 15½(15½-17½-17½-17½)" [35.5-35.5-44.5-44.5-44.5)cm]

Sleeve Length: 12½(12½-13½-13½-13½)" [32(32-34.5-34.5-34.5)cm]

Abbreviations: K, knit; p, purl; St st, stockinette stitch; sts, stitches; rep, repeat; beg, begin or beginning; rem, remain or remaining; inc, increase; dec, decrease; yo, yarn over; tog, together; ", inches; cm, centimeters.

Please follow washing instructions printed on yarn label.

Back: Using smaller needles and Color 1 yarn, cast on 68(72-78-84-92) sts and work in k 1, p 1 ribbing for 2" [5 cm], inc 1 st on last rib row-69(73-79-85-93) sts. Change to larger needles and Color 2 and beg with a k row, proceed to work in St st-one row k, one row p for 14(14-16-16-16) rows, change to Color 1 and work 2 rows in garter st-every row k. Change to Color 3 and work 14(14-16-16-16) rows in St st. Change to Color 1 and work 2 rows in garter st, change to Color 4 and work 14(14-16-16-16) rows in St st. Change to color 1 and work 2 rows in garter st, change to color 5 and work 14(14-16-16-16) rows in St st. Change to color 1

and work 2 rows in garter st, change to color 6 and work 14(14-16-16-16) rows in St st. Change to color 1 and work 2 rows in garter st. Change to color 7 and work 13(13-15-15-15) rows in St st. **Next Row:** Cast off 19(21-23-25-28) sts, place next 31(31-33-35-37) sts on st holder for neckband, join on another ball of yarn and cast off rem sts.

Left Front: Using smaller needles and Color 1 yarn, cast on 32(34-36-40-44) sts and work in k 1, p 1 ribbing for 2" [5 cm]. Change to larger needles and Color 2 yarn and work in color changes as for back until you have worked 0(0-2-2-2) rows of color 7.

Neck Shaping: Next Row: Continuing with color 7, k to end. **Next row:** P 8 sts, place these sts on st holder for neckband, work to end. ****Continue in St st, dec one st at neck edge on next and every row following 3(3-3-5-6) times, then every alternate row once. Work even on rem 19(21-23-25-28) sts until front measures same as back to shoulder. Cast off.****

Right Front: Work as for left front to beg of neck shaping. **Next Row:** Continuing with color 7, k 8, place these sts on st holder for neckband, k to end. Work one row even. Now work from ** to ** of left front.

Sew shoulder seams.

Sleeves: Using smaller needles and Color 1 yarn, cast on 36(38-38-40-40) sts and work in k 1, p 1 ribbing for 1" [2.5 cm]. Change to larger needles and Color 2 and beg with a k row work in St st, changing colors as for back and inc one st at each end of the 5th row, then every 4th row until you have 62(64-64-66-66) sts. Work even, continuing to change colors as before until sleeve measures 12½(12½-13½-13½-13½)" [32(32-34.5-34.5-34.5)cm] from beg. Cast off.

Buttonband: Worked on the left front for a girl or the right front for a boy.

Using smaller needles and Color 1, pick up and k 84(84-98-98-98) sts along front edge and work in k 1, p 1 ribbing for 1" [2.5 cm]. Cast off ribwise.

Mark positions for 5 buttons, placing one ½" [1 cm] from bottom edge, allowing for 1 in neckband and spacing rem ones evenly between.

Buttonhole Band: Using smaller needles and color 1 yarn, pick up and k 84(84-98-98-98) sts along front edge of opposite side. Work in k 1, p 1 ribbing for 3 rows. **Next Row:** Rib to first marker, *yo, work 2 tog, rib to next marker; rep from * to last marker, yo, work 2 tog, rib to end. Work 3 more rows in rib as set. Cast off ribwise.

Neckband: Using smaller needles and Color 1 yarn, pick up and k 80(80-84-84-84) sts around neck edge, including those on st holders. Work in k 1 p 1 ribbing, making buttonhole as required. When neckband measures 1" [2.5 cm], cast off ribwise.

To Complete: Fold sleeves in half lengthwise. Place a fold at each shoulder seam and sew sleeves in place on fronts and back. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons to match buttonholes.
